Tiger Huang & Friends to serenade fans this June at Arena of Stars, Resorts World Genting

In 2012, Cyndi had her inaugural solo concert and nine years later, in March 2021, Cyndi and Lin Junyi held a concert together at Taipei International Convention Center. Cyndi has also starred in various dramas such as “It Started with a Kiss” and its sequel “They Kiss Again”.

Performing alongside these talented vocal queens is none other than Roger Yang, the Taiwanese rock singer dubbed as the “Iron Lung Prince” by the Taiwanese media and the “Treble God” by his fans. Roger, despite only being discovered in his mid-30s, topped the Taiwanese chart for 37 weeks straight with his hit song, “I Believe” using his powerful octave-jumping vocal skills and ability to sing high notes effortlessly without using falsetto.

Together and individually, they will serenade the audience and take fans on a walk down memory lane through their journey in the music industry.
